Dear Families,

Please find attached our updated Incident, Injury, Trauma and Illness policy.

I have outlined the key changes to this policy:

'Any child with a high fever or temperature reaching 38°C or higher will not be permitted to attend the Service until 24 hours after the temperature/fever has subsided without pain relief. You may be asked for a medical clearance to return to care.'

'To protect children within our service, all children who receive vaccinations (immunisations and flu-shots inclusive) are able to return to care the following day after they receive the injection.'
