Professional Development - Mandatory Reporting by Bugs and Bare Feet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discussed the impact we have on a child's life and how important it is to make the children feel safe and secure so that they can talk to us if needed. • Looked at the different types of abuse and what we might see. • Discussed statistically what children might be at risk of abuse • Discussed the process of mandatory reporting, how to document, where to report too, how to talk with a child that had disclosed to you. • Discussed different scenarios about what we would do if a child had bruises on his back or if an immobile child had bruises, nappy rash and blood in its nappy. We discussed in groups what we would do in each situation and then as group discussed how we would handle each situation and what we should do. • Discussed who is a mandatory reported in the service • How to document an incident correctly and where to report it. • Discussed if a parent was under the influence of alcohol or drugs that you suspected and what to do in that situation. <p>He will also send us a copy of the slide show as well as the certificate.
